The Family Success Coach is a seasoned professional who takes an intentional strengths based approach to working with families in the agency's scattered site and project based supportive housing programs. Through their interactions with the Family Success Coach, families develop skills to articulate their own self-sufficiency goals and find their own paths to achieve them.

The Family Support Coach's role is to help families shift their perspectives and discover different solutions to the challenges they face through intensive case management, supportive therapy, motivational interviewing, consistent follow-up and a harm reduction approach. The goal is to help the family recognize and understand underlying causes of their challenges, identify their own skills and capabilities and then use those skills to cope more effectively and achieve self-sufficiency.

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Social Work or Psychology required. Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) or Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC) credential preferred
- Minimum of 5 years of experience working with low income families from diverse backgrounds required.
- Experience conducting home assessments and working with medically complex families, including those affected by HIV/AIDS, preferred.
- Must have a valid Illinois driver's license and appropriate auto insurance.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) written and verbal communication skills preferred.
