## **Supportive Housing Program Supervisor Child & Family Support Services**

The Supportive Housing Program Supervisor is a seasoned professional who provides leadership for the agency's scattered site and project based supportive housing programs and community based mental health services. Through their interactions with the supportive housing team, families develop skills to articulate their own self-sufficiency goals and find their own paths to achieve them.

The Supportive Housing Program Supervisor's role is to ensure the delivery of effective services that will engage and help families shift their perspectives and discover different solutions to the challenges they face through intensive case management, supportive therapy, consistent follow-up and utilizing an understanding of stages of change and a harm reduction approach.

### Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Social Work, Psychology or related field required. Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) or Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC) credential preferred.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience working with low income families from diverse backgrounds required; experience with supportive housing programs and working with HIV-affected families preferred.
- Must demonstrate commitment to evidence-based (or –informed) practice and programming, including contributing to knowledge development and dissemination.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish written and verbal communication skills preferred).
