Mental Health and Disabilities Coordinator

The Mental Health and Disabilities Coordinator is responsible for coordinating the mental health and disability components of the Early Childhood Education program. This position plays a critical role in the planning, development and implementation of service plans for children with disabilities and mental health needs. The Mental Health and Disabilities Coordinator provides critical support to children in their emotional, cognitive, and social development, toward an overall goal of social competence and school readiness.

The Mental Health and Disabilities Coordinator functions as a member of a team which includes the Program Manager, Education Coordinator, Teachers, Family Support Specialists, School Nurse, and parents to achieve the goals set for children in the Early Childhood Education program.

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in Social Work and Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) credential required.
- Minimum of 3 years of experience working with infants/toddlers and preschool children and families in a mental health setting required.
- Demonstrated ability to work with families with young children who have disabilities and knowledge of child disability/mental health conditions preferred.
- Knowledge of Head Start/Early Head Start performance standards preferred.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) written and verbal communication skills preferred.
